Rogerstone Ward Priority

The priority for the Rogerstone ward is drug dealing In the Rogerstone area.

Actions/Activities by the local Neighbourhood Policing Team

Patrols have been conducted by the Neighbourhood Team with a focus on our priority of drug dealing in the area and further intelligence has been submitted. We have also received reports of other drug hotspots in the area and these are now being monitored. It was reported that a vehicle had been left abandoned outside the Tiny Rebel. Upon attendance the vehicle was heavily damaged and at risk of being vandalised. The vehicle was recovered. Officers also seized a vehicle in the same area for having no insurance. We have continued to receive received complaints regarding parked vehicles causing an obstruction however officers have attended and no parking offences have been committed.

The team has continued to work extremely hard this month to engage with vulnerable adults living within the ward. They have received regular visits from the team to check their welfare, wellbeing and to discuss any issues that they may have.
