Actions/Activities by the local Neighbourhood Policing Team

Patrols have been conducted by the Neighbourhood Team with a focus on our priority of drug dealing in the area.

Operation Senior has seen new members added and our vulnerable residents are happy with our monthly visits.

Anti-Social behaviour patrols carried out in the area of Rogerstone Train Station, Welfare Grounds, Fourteen Locks and Jubilee Park.

6 x ASB warning letters sent to parents / guardians to highlight children's behaviour.

The team have conducted joint visits with Newport City Homes in the areas of Oak Road to target ASB and encourage residents to report issues to police.

We have started up our Mini Police at High Cross Primary School, well done to all pupils who have joined up. Mini Police at Rogerstone Primary School will be set up in due course.

The team have been conducting Operation Bang in the build up to Halloween and Bonfire Night.

Halloween – Only two reports of anti-social behaviour and fireworks in the areas of Thornbury Park and Cefn Wood Estates. No other issues.

1 x Vehicle seized for no insurance in the area of Ruskin Avenue.
